Led by attorneys Richard Samson and Karen Brandon (Ogletree, Deakins, Nash, Smoak & Stewart, P.C.), this presentation entitled "Is There an Alternate to the Union Pension Plan and Can We Bargain a New Way Forward?" at CONNECT on Wednesday, October 5 at 2:00 p.m. is for the union contractor

who provides benefits to employees through the jointly trusteed union and management benefit funds. Focusing on retirement plans, the traditional plan offered to union employers has been the defined benefit pension plan. This is in contrast to the non-union workforce which is typically covered by a 401(k) plan. During the collective bargaining process the retirement plan can be negotiated. We will discuss:

- Defined benefit vs. defined contribution plans
- Who makes the decisions for the plan?
- How are employer contributions determined?
- How is withdrawal liability created and triggered?
- Hybrid plan arrangements, how to find out if your plan has one and benefits to the employer
- Is there an alternative to the traditional pension plan?
- Using the collective bargaining process as a possible means to obtain desired changes
